

MONTESSORI LANGUAGE CURRICULUM GUIDELINES :

Parents,

When helping your child with letter recognition, please keep in mind some of the things we are focusing on in the classroom. The child in the Pre/K Montessori room is introduced to lowercase letters first. The letter-sound is what he/she learns in the beginning. So the letter "m" is identified by its sound "mmm...".

Please look over the letter sounds so you'll be familiar with them.

a: as in apple, alligator

b: as in ball, big

c: as in cap, car

d: as in dog, down

e: as in elephant, egg

f: as in frog, fish

g: as in garage, garden

h: as in house, hill

i: as in igloo, ink

j: as in jam, jar

k: as in kitten, kite

l: as in lid, little

m: as in mouse, milk

n: as in nest, north

o: as in octopus, otter

p: as in pumpkin, pot

q: as in queen, quail

r: as in robin, rock

s: as in sing, sat

t: as in turtle, tin

u: as in umbrella, up

v: as in violin

w: as in wagon, well

x: as in xox, xox

y: as in yak, yellow

z: as in zoo, zebra
